# Challenge

Most of the current locations use old subway style tripod turnstiles for access control, with members swiping barcoded plastic cards to gain entry.

These units, which had reached the end of their useful life did not permit high volume user throughput to support large events or busy periods at the facility; and they did not support wheelchair or child stroller access.

# Solution

An extensive evaluation found that the Fastlane® Glassgate 150 optical turnstiles from Smarter Security® appeared to offer the best possible price/performance ratio of any turnstiles on the market, as measured against safety, security, and throughput volumes.
